Latest Pre-Orders

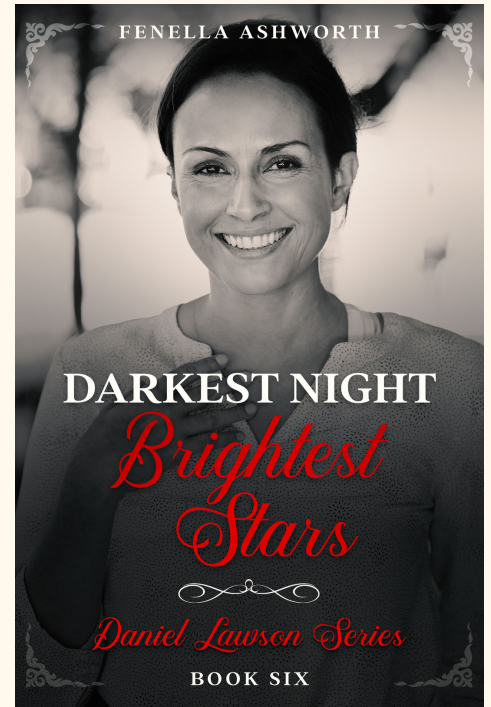

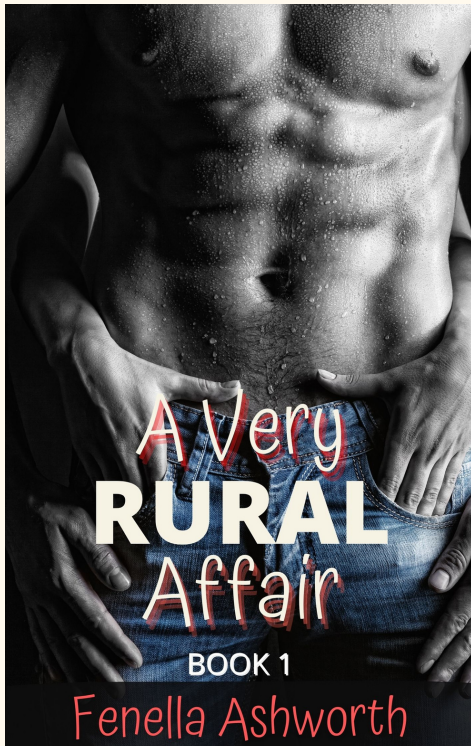


A Very Rural Affair
